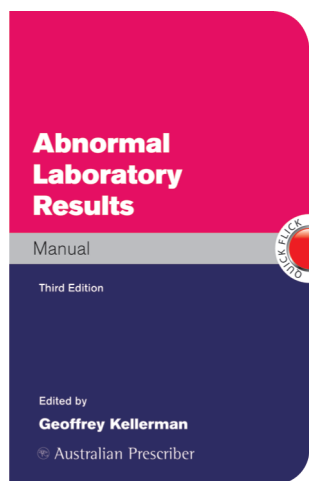


Abnormal laboratory results
